9. Military Order of the Purple Heart Presentation – Commander Charles R. Stanford, MOPH-Chapter 758- Tallahassee, FL: Mr. Stanford stated that he was retired USMC. Mr. Stanford stated it was a great honor to be invited to these presentations. Mr. Stanford went on to give some history of the Purple Heart from its beginning to present day. Mr. Stanford went on to give some statistics. Mr. Stanford was well received with a great round of applause.
10. Prince – Marker Family Presentation of Purple Heart Limited Addition Print: Ms. Patricia Hinton presented the Council and Town of Greenville a beautiful limited addition Purple Heart print. Ms. Hinton and her brother Vietnam veteran, John Marker, Jr. conducted research for the print from the original George Washington Papers in the Library of Congress. Ms. Hinton stated that it was a great honor to present the print to the town on behalf of her family. Mayor Dansey thanked Ms. Hinton on behalf of the council and town.
11. Comments by Town Council, Town Attorney and Town Manager and Town Clerk: Mr. Dean thanked all the veterans in attendance for their service and continued service to the nation and this community. Mr. Dean went on to state that as part of the Youth Build Project the American Legion folks had volunteered their services to tutor. Mr. Dean announced that on Thursday afternoon he had received notification that the town had received the CDBG grant for the Senior/Youth Center. Mr. Dean stated that we would now go into the environmental review process and he expected that to take 90 to 120 days. Mr. Dean gave a brief description of the Youth and Senior Center uses. Councilmember Bobby Burnett thanked Mr. Dean for his hard work in acquiring this grant. Mr. Dean asked Mr. Malone, Public Works Director to give a brief report about the project at the school. Mr. Malone stated that the school project was moving along as planned and was expected to finish on time. Mr. Reid stated that he was drafting the final language for Municode and hoped to have something to bring back soon. Ms. Reams stated that she didn't have anything to report. Ms. Reams stated that she was waiting for the Supervisor of Elections to get her the dates for qualifying for the upcoming election. She went on to state that it would most likely be January 14th until January 18th. Ms. Reams stated that Seats 3 and 4 were up for election. Morris Bell, Recreation Coordinator spoke about former Greenville athletes and the positive impact they have on the children of Greenville. Mr. Bell stated that he thought it would be appropriate to recognize these individuals.
12. Future Agenda Item Requests: Discussion of possible ways to recognize athletes.
13. Informational Items: Mayor Dansey stated that there would be a Special Session on December 17th at 6:00 PM for the second reading of the flood ordinance.
