ORDINANCE NO. 2018-245

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF GREENVILLE, FLORIDA, AMENDING SECTION 10 OF ORDINANCE NO. 158 OF SAID TOWN; PROVIDING FOR AMENDMENTS TO THE FEES AND CHARGES FOR THE REMOVAL AND DISPOSAL OF GARBAGE, TRASH, PAYMENT OF SUCH FEES AND CHARGES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF ALL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF GREENVILLE, FLORIDA; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town of Greenville, Florida, adopted Ordinance No. 158 to impose a monthly fee for garbage, trash, and refuse removal and disposal, and

WHEREAS, because of rising expenses incurred by the Town of Greenville, Florida, to provide sanitation services to its residents, the Town of Greenville, Florida, has not been able to cover such expenses with the current fee structure, and therefore, the Town Council of the Town of Greenville, Florida, has deemed it necessary to increase said monthly fee.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GREENVILLE, FLORIDA, that:**

Section 1. Fees and Charges for Removal of Garbage by the Town. Section 10 of Ordinance No. 158 of the Town of Greenville, Florida is amended to read:

Section 10. FEES AND CHARGES FOR REMOVAL OF GARBAGE BY THE TOWN: There is hereby established the following minimum uniform monthly schedule of rates and charges for the collection, removal, and disposal of garbage in the Town of Greenville, Florida; such fees and charges to be paid by the owner, tenant, or occupant of the premises from which such garbage is produced, collected, supplied, gathered, or furnished:

For all of the above categories, except no. 3, an extra charge of \$20.00 per load shall be made for all removals in excess of one load on any one day.

Following the adjustment on October 01, 2018, all of the above monthly rates and charges shall increase on October 1<sup>st</sup> of each year, beginning on October 01, 2019, by two and one-half percent (2.5%).

Section 2. Severability. The provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable, and if any section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance shall, for any reason, be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, sentences, clauses, and phrases of this Ordinance, but shall remain in effect, it being the legislative intent that this Ordinance shall stand notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.

Section 3. Repeal of conflicting ordinances. Any and all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict. Ordinances Nos. 160, 164, 168, 178, 186, 190, and 242 are hereby repealed in their entirety.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect on October 01, 2018.
