

ORDINANCE NO. 2024-276

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GREENVILLE, FLORIDA; ADOPTING THE FINAL LEVYING OF AD VALOREM TAXES FOR MADISON COUNTY FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023; REPEALING CONFLICTING RESOLUTIONS AND ORDINANCES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Greenville, Florida was notified by the Florida Department of Revenue that a prior action taken to levy ad valorem taxes needed to be corrected and that the need for such corrective action was urgent; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Greenville, Florida, adopts this ordinance in compliance with statutory procedures for emergency ordinances pursuant to § 166.041(3)(b), FLA. STAT. (2023); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to applicable provisions of law, the Town of Greenville of Madison County has computed a final millage rate and prepared a final budget for the fiscal year, beginning October 01, 2023 and ending on September 30, 2024; and

WHEREAS, a “Notice of Budget Hearing” advising the public that a public hearing on the final millage rate would be held on January 08, 2024, at 5:30 P.M. has been published as required by § 200.065, FLA. STAT. (2023); and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Greenville of Madison County, Florida, held an advertised public hearing on Monday, January 08, 2024 at 5:30 P.M. as required by § 200.065, FLA. STAT. (2023); and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Greenville of Madison County, Florida, on January 08, 2024, adopted Fiscal Year Final Millage Rates following a public hearing as required by § 200.065, FLA. STAT. (2023); and

WHEREAS, the gross taxable value for operating purposes not exempt from taxation within Madison County has been certified by the County Property Appraiser to the Town of Greenville as **\$14,769,053.00**;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GREENVILLE, FLORIDA as follows:

SECTION 1. The FY 2023-2024 operating millage rate is 10.000 mills, which is more than the rolled back rate of 8.8708 mills, and is a 12.73% increase.

SECTION 2. Any and all ordinances or resolutions or any parts of ordinances or resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
