ORDINANCE NO. 2024-279

AN ORDINANCE RELATED TO CHARTER OFFICER TITLES AND JOB DESCRIPTIONS; AMENDING SEC. 2-44, CODE OF GENERAL ORDINANCES; REMOVING OPERATIONAL JOB TITLE OF TOWN MANAGER; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GREENVILLE, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. Section 2-44 of the Code of General Ordinances of the Town of Greenville, Florida, is hereby amended and shall read as follows:

Sec. 2-44. – Town Manager.

- (a) Appointment; Removal; Compensation.
 - (1) Appointment. The Town Council shall appoint the Town Manager by the affirmative vote of the Town Council.
 - (2) Removal. The Town Manager may be removed by the affirmative vote of the Town Council upon reasonable notice at a publicly noticed meeting. The action of the Town Council shall be final.
 - (3) Compensation. The compensation of the Town Manager shall be fixed by the Town Council.
- (b) ~~Operational Job Title.~~
 - (1) ~~The Town Manager shall operate under the official title of Chief Executive Officer/Chief Financial Officer, or CEO/CFO.~~
- (c) Job duties of Town Manager.
 - (1) The Town Manager shall be the chief administrative officer of the Town. The Manager shall be responsible to the Council for the administration of Town Affairs.
 - (2) The job duties and responsibilities of the Town Manager, ~~operating as the Chief Executive Officer/Chief Financial Officer,~~ shall be further defined by policy adopted by the Town Council and incorporated by reference.

Section 2. Severability. The provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable, and if any section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance shall, for any reason, be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections,

sentences, clauses, and phrases of this Ordinance, but shall remain in effect, it being the legislative intent that this Ordinance shall stand notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.

Section 3. Repeal of conflicting ordinances. Any and all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
